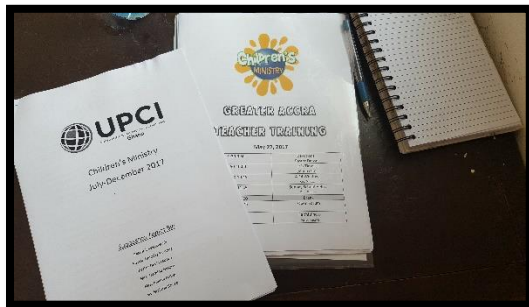


- I attended my first Ghanaian wedding on May 20 where I witnessed Pastor Gilbert Madjie and Esther Opong devote the rest of their lives to one another.
