



### *“Co-Mission” – Jesus and Me (Isaiah 61:1-4; Luke 4:18)*

By God’s enablement (Grace) and empowerment (Anointing), we’ve been in “Co-Mission” with Him - preaching The Gospel: The poor are being made rich, blind are seeing, deaf are hearing, captives (in bondage) and prisoners are being delivered, liberated, and set free. The sick, bruised, wounded, and brokenhearted/crushed are being healed, restored, and made whole. The weak are being made strong. The oppressed and tormented are going out free with a sound mind. There is no way to list it all. If one picture is worth a thousand words, then many words can be said about the people in the pictures below. These consist of several national village churches, five orphanages, a leper colony, and more...



Orphans and Lepers: One 20x10 room housed twenty boys who slept on the cement floor. All they owned was a trunk or backpack. Lepers were brought by others and some crawled into church. Many were missing their body parts and showed active infections. Knowing this day would come, it still stretched my faith when I thought of the realities of my health limitations - but I was determined "fear" would have no place in His Perfected Love in me and that He'd give us Great Grace to do His Will. Everywhere we went, people wanted us to pray for them; virtue would go out from us as we ministered to as many as we could. In four days, with literally only a few hours of rest, we went from one place to another to reach as many as that day would allow. The work is GREAT, but He is GREATER!

### *“GO” Forth (Mark 16:20)*

In one of the larger village churches we visited, as the Pastor of the assembly was addressing his congregation, he began to tell of how their Church had went on a Church-wide three day fast specifically for the youth. He felt God wanted to use them in a special way in this hour. At the end of that fast, The Lord had given him a vision of a man he did not know, and had never met, that came to the church and sat in a chair in a certain place. This man had something to transfer to them. He said today when he looked up, he saw that man in the very place and chair he had visioned. He pointed to Bro. Anderson and told the congregation, “You’re that man.” He said, “I feel God has brought you here and you’re to pray for all our youth here, and when you do, God is going to release some things through you to them to use them in this hour.” So Bro. Anderson, Bro. Miller (India UPCI Missionary), and the Pastor jointly began to lay hands on as many youth as were there and pray. In this same church, when Bro. Miller preached, he felt to tell his testimony. Afterward people lined up to be prayed for – Bro. Anderson said, “They just would not stop coming and I could not stop praying.” During that same time of prayer, Sis. Anderson laid hands on a young lady named Michelle and told her, “God has given you a new Gift today that is being released.” Afterwards, Michelle approached Sis. Anderson and revealed who she was (the Pastor’s daughter) and that she received a new tongue at the moment Sis. Anderson laid hands on her (she already had The Holy Ghost). Then it was evident that Michelle received and released a new dialect or “Divers Kinds of Tongues” (1 Cor. 12:10). Only God knows the numbers that were added to The Church that day and what all was done in the lives of those there.



### *Praise Report*

- In our last Newsletter we spoke of a young man (Shan) we had prayed for and Jesus healed. Shortly after that, his Mom was admitted into the hospital with heart troubles and he had to immediately return to his village home/city.
