## WHAT WE'RE UP TO

*Tabernaculo De Vida* is the church we are privileged to serve in under the supervision of Missionaries Ken and Kay Burgess. Our main responsibility while we are here is to pastor the English church. There are several nationalities that make up the English church. We have ministered so far to people from the Philippines, Nigeria, Jamaica, Ivory Coast, Ghana, Liberia, England, and Norway - just to name a few. Dawn teaches the children in Sunday School and Corey preaches in the service. Corey also works in the offices and print shop during the day. The print shop makes literature both for the local and national church as well as the bible school.



## SPAIN IN AUGUST

The month of August in Spain is quite different than in the United States. Most of the country takes their vacation time in August. It's quite common for some businesses to close for the entire month. Many people in the church work inside homes and often have to travel with their employers while on vacation. This of course affects church attendance and activities. During this time, *Tabernaculo De Vida* has only one Spanish service on Sunday instead of the normal two.

However, God isn't on vacation! We have still seen many baptized and Spirit filled in our services this month. August has a slower pace than most months, but September is when things get going strong. Schools and colleges start again including our own Theological Bible Institute with campuses in Madrid and Barcelona. We will be starting cell groups again and the English church has four which we will be overseeing.

## REVIVAL IN SPAIN

The goal of the National Church in Spain is to double their churches/preaching points by the year 2020. They call it "Vision 20/20". *Tabernaculo de Vida* alone has eight daughter works, many of them are fairly new. I was privileged to attend the one year anniversary of the daughter work in Mosteles which is the second largest city in the Autonomous Community of Madrid with a population of over 200,000. Bro. Burgess preached and there was a powerful spirit of sacrifice and a burden for the city. It's exciting to see what the Lord is doing now and the great potential there is for the future!
