We have arrived, nearly finished our immigration papers, found an apartment (finally, after 3 weeks!), and are getting acquainted with the church and the area.

### Highlights of this month:

- Our first service in Barcelona was a joy to help pray and work in the altars on Pentecost Sunday- 6 were filled with the Holy Ghost!
- We started our first weeks in service at Los Pentecostales de Barcelona as well as ministering in the Filipino church. We were also privileged to see the daughter work and new construction in Manresa and minister there.
- Y.O.M. came to Barcelona with 102 participants! We had a busy week preparing for services, showing them highlights of Barcelona, and participating in outreach. Four received the Holy Ghost, one was baptized, several healings were reported, and many contacts made.
- We have been learning our administrative roles in the church office, as well as becoming involved in music and ministry

We landed in Barcelona on May 31st quite excited and overwhelmed at the same time. We were not sure quite what to expect our first month here. We only knew that the Lord had directed us to this city/region (Catalunya) and we wanted “to be about our Father’s business...” The paperwork that had to be accomplished this first month in order to qualify to rent an apartment proved to be quite daunting. There were times where we felt like everything was about to fall into place, and then something would change. After three weeks we were finally able open a bank account, find a landlord that would rent to extranjeros (foreigners), and register with the local government. Every time we began to doubt, we remembered how He had miraculously provided for all our needs and confirmed His will thus far. We are incredibly grateful for the faithful support and prayers of our friends and family.

It is a great privilege to work under Missionaries Nathan and Tanya Harrod and participate in the revival. There is still a great work to be done. It is the vision of Bro. Harrod and the church to start two new daughter works by the end of the year. The AIM program is described as being an extra set of hands to the missionary. We are working to take on some of the labor here to free up the hands of the missionaries so they can see that vision accomplished. **Pray** with us that we be effective in all we do as we seek to take on more administrative responsibilities, edify the church, and reach the lost. Whenever we began to feel inadequate the Lord reminded us that it is He that helps us with our weaknesses and makes intercession for

us (Romans 8). Our mission does not hinge upon our own talents and abilities but “according to the power that worketh in us.” Only the Holy Spirit could make a difference when a husband grabbed for our hand to pray for him and his wife, or the Lord directed us to help pray with a backslider as she sought repentance in the altar, or we saw a lady claim healing and say that heat entered into her body as she felt a chronic abdominal condition leave after a group of us prayed the prayer of faith. God is faithful, and it is our AIM to be faithful to His calling. Amidst all the paperwork and getting settled this past month, we have also been quite busy getting to know the work, the people, and the area. It is an honor to work alongside the wonderful people in the Lord’s harvest. We are looking forward to beginning our first of hopefully many home Bible Studies this week with a man who has brought his wife and daughter to a couple services. God blessed us with a great connection with them and we are in great expectation to see the doors that it will open and that it will lead to a relationship with their Savior. Pray with us that God helps to continue to make improvement in the language and that we walk through open doors to be a witness in the community. Pray that the light that was in the life of Jesus Christ and is now shed abroad in our hearts continues to expel the darkness from a city where spirits of depression, anxiety, and perversion have sought to rule the hearts and minds of the people. Revival is happening.
