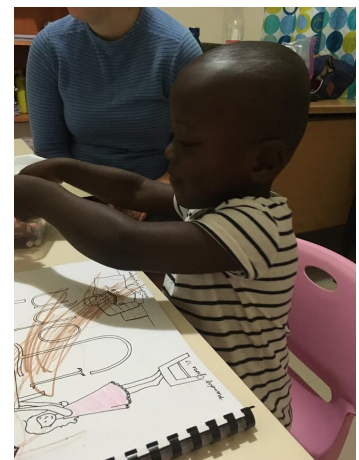


Rebekah Thompson
