Things have been moving so fast, it seems as though we just arrived in Malta, yet 27 weeks have passed since we began our time as Furlough Missionaries. However, there is a lot to share since our last newsletter.

The relationships that we've been cultivating have begun to bear fruit as doors open wide:

- 1) Gil and Teresa along with their two children have really opened up and we have become good friends. Bible studies are exciting with them as they are so hungry for spiritual things.
- 2) We were recently invited to Marco and Joanna's home in Hal Balzan where they cooked a traditional Maltese dish of fried rabbit and sausage. Afterward we had a long Bible discussion followed by prayer. This couple and their two children desire the blessings of God. While their spiritual roots are deeply traditional, they experienced the power of the Holy Spirit when we prayed with them.
- 3) With the cities of Hal Bazan, Taxien, Hal Ghaxaq, Msida and several others, our list of cities in which we have done prayer walks and outreach has grown to 31. The Capital city of Valletta has been walked in prayer 12 times. Sliema has been walked in prayer 8 times and we have handed out several hundred pieces of literature while on outreach there.
- 4) The Sunday "after service discipleship class" has seven members involved. This class is designed to help saints to grow in the Word so that they may be more effectual witnesses for Jesus!
- 5) The Filipino community within the church continues to prosper. We were invited for dinner and met several more families who we hope to reach. Please pray for the Filipinos here. They are hard workers and many come to Malta to support their families back in the Philippines.

Please pray for the people of Malta and those who work hard within the church so that this country can be reached with the only saving gospel of Jesus Christ.

Also, pray for an opportunity which has arisen in which the church may be able to purchase a building in the city of Rabat as a static meeting place within this country.
