Our extension locations with the Bible School completed the first quarter classes on the "Book of Acts" and kicked off a new quarter with "Introduction to the Bible." We wrapped up the month with our national conference and assembly sessions. Thirty minutes before the opening night service even started, a man (pictured above) walked in off the street because he heard the music of the choir practicing.
