We have a young sister in the church who is only 16 years old. She received some news from her doctor that she had a large cyst on one of her ovaries. The news of the cyst terrified her because the doctor told her that she would not be able to have children. On a Tuesday night prayer, she was in a lot of pain. She was in so much pain that she was crying and had to sit down on the bench. We began to pray with her and believed that God would heal and touch her body. We decided that the pain was so bad we needed to take her to the hospital. We went to a hospital where they were able to perform an ultrasound. The doctor told her that the cyst was in fact gone! She will now return in one month for a follow-up appointment.
