Hello again from the marvelous city of Warsaw, Poland!

This month we had two new AIMers join our team in Warsaw. They went through about a week of training in Riga, Latvia and then were able to join the church there for their annual conference. During RBD training they not only had class time but they also had time to do practicum. This involved taking what they learned in a sit down setting and being able to apply it to everyday interactions, or evangelism.

Upon their arrival they did not miss a beat. We continue(d) to do prayer walks, evangelism and RBD training. It is so very important that we all continue to learn and grow, not just from our experiences, but that we would allow the Word of God to teach us something new everyday, and that we would apply biblical principles into our everyday life. We are always called to be witnesses of Him.

We are building more and more connections. One thing we have noticed is that in this area of the world it takes a lot more to build trust with someone, and that's okay. God has given us favor and we are doing it. There are a lot of people who profess to have a form of experience with God, and though we do not deny their experience (because to them it was REAL, and it was), we do notice where there is a lack of relationship.

This month we are praying that God continues to give us the boldness to stand tall, and to be the difference that the people need to see and that they desire to be a part of. Most importantly that they are able to see HIM and desire to have not just another experience, but a real connection to a very real God.

We do have house church every Sunday, and we also have game night which sometimes turns into a Bible study on Wednesday nights. We do not always have people come, but again, it comes with time, lots of relationship building, patience and just allowing God to be Who He is, and to do what He does
